

Instructions for Completing the PAP Application Form

***All ETSI faculty, spouses and partners must complete this PAP form.
(Each individual must fill out a separate PAP form.)***

Line 9 a & b – References:

We have pre-filled this information for faculty and staff participating in the 2018 Emory-Tibet Science Initiative Summer Program in India.

Line 11 – Details of Visa for India (if obtained):

Non-faculty members, who will not teach at the monasteries and who have valid Indian tourist visa can write their Indian visa number here. But all ETSI faculty members must write, "Applying for visa". ETSI Faculty members must apply for an 'X-Entry visa' since they will be teaching at the monasteries.

Line 12 - Proposed Place to be Visited:

Line 13 – Intended Route:

Mumbai and Bangalore to the Tibetan Monasteries (Drepung, Gaden, and Sera).

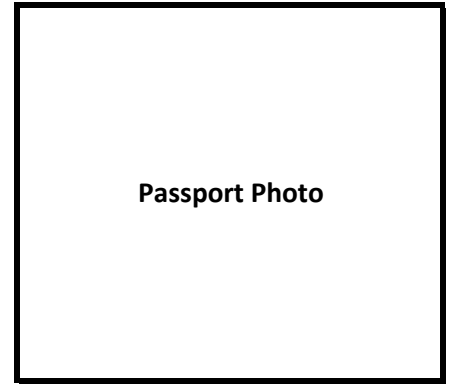
